Biography of Mr. Tan Kah Kee

Mr. Tan Kah Kee was born on October 21, 1874 to an overseas business family in Jimei (formerly a small village of Tongan County), Xiamen, Fujian. At the age of 17, he travelled to Singapore to work at his father's shop. After years of hard work, he gained great success and was known as the 'Rubber Magnate' of the Southeast Asia. Bearing in mind that 'education is vital to the development of the nation and running a school is the due responsibility of the people, he returned home in 1913. He established Jimei Schools including Kindergarten, Primary School, Middle School, Teachers' College, Fisheries, Navigation, Business, Agronomy and Xiamen University thereafter. During the anti-Japanese war, he was elected councilor for Nanyang Overseas Chinese Chamber for Relief – a Fund-raising for Charity for the Refugees of the Motherland. He made tremendous contributions to the victory of the Chinese anti-Japanese war and gained high respect from compatriots at home and abroad. In 1949, Tan Kah Kee moved back to China and was appointed Vice Chairmen of the CPPCC, Member of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress, and the first Chairman of the Chinese Federation of Overseas Chinese. He passed away on August 12, 1961.

Tan Kah Kee is a renowned patriotic overseas Chinese leader, an outstanding entrepreneur, an educator, and social activist. With deep love for his motherland, he invested all his fortunes in education and offered his selfless service for the benefit of humanity. He made tremendous contributions to the independence and liberation of the motherland. Mao Zedong praised and called him "the flag of the overseas Chinese and the glory of the nation". In memory of Tan Kah Kee for his special contributions, on March 11, 1990, the International Asteroid Center and Asteroid Nomination Committee named him Asteroid 2963 'Tan Kah Kee Star.'



A Letter of Correspondence from President Xi Jinping

In October, 2014, on the occasion of the 140th Anniversary of the birth of Mr. Tan Kah Kee, General Secretary of the CPC, President of PRC and Chairman of the Military Commission of CPC Xi Jinping sent a letter of correspondence to Xiamen Jimei Alumni Association, calling for the overseas Chinese to promote the "Tan Kah Kee Spirit" – be patriotic and strive for the realization of the dream of the national rejuvenation – together with the people in the motherland.

The following is the content of the letter by President Xi:

On this special occasion of the 140th Anniversary of the birth of Mr. Tan Kah Kee, I cherish my profound memory of him and extend my sincere greetings to his families and relatives.

Mr. Tan Kah Kee is "the flag of the overseas Chinese and the glory of the nation". I worked in Fujian for many years, and I fully acknowledged the great contributions he had made to his motherland, especially for his hometown, Fujian. Being the leader and a good example for overseas Chinese, he is patriotic and devoted himself to education as a career. He joined the national salvation movement, promoted unity among overseas Chinese, and strived for the liberation of the nation. His spirit of hard work and self-striving to attain a goal, his virtue of putting the nation and the country first, and his concern for the development of the country, as well as his sincerity to the cause of education are always worth learning.

The realization of the great rejuvenation of China as a nation is the common aspiration of Chinese at home and abroad. It is also the lifelong pursuit of Mr. Tan Kah Kee and our forefathers. I hope the overseas Chinese will continue to promote the "Tan Kah Kee's Spirit" – be patriotic and strive for the recognition of the dream of the national rejuvenation – together with the people in the motherland.

Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

01 Brief Introduction to Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

Tan Kah Kee Scholarship was set up in 2017 to further implement the spirit of the letter of Correspondence of General Secretary Xi Jinping to Jimei Alumni Association, to better promote the monumental contributions of the famous patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, to inherit and to carry forward the Tan Kah Kee Spirit as well as to attract and encourage the outstanding overseas Chinese students and Chinese descendants to pursue their studies in Xiamen.

The scholarship mainly comes from the dividend yield from Hong Kong Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. of Jimei Schools Committee to support the overseas Chinese students, Chinese descendants from the countries of "Maritime Silk Road" or Jimei Schools alumni descendants in Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan to study in 7 schools and universities including Xiamen University, Jimei University, Huaqiao University (Xiamen campus), Xiamen University of Technology, Xiamen Ocean Vocational College, Jimei Industrial School and Jimei Middle school.

02 Brief Introduction to Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation of Xiamen

Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation of Xiamen is a non-public funded foundation whose income mainly comes from the donation from Jimei Schools Committee, Hong Kong Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. as well as people from all walks of life.

The objective of the Foundation is to set up Tan Kah Kee Scholarship in order to fund the overseas Chinese students and Jimei Schools alumni descendants from Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan for the pursuit of their studies in Xiamen, to honor the outstanding teachers and students from schools and universities of Jimei Schools Village, to fund the academic workshop on publication and research of Mr. Tan Kah Kee, and to help excellent but poverty-stricken students who deserve the award.

03 Funding Criteria

The scholarship covers such expenses as tuition, accommodation allowance, teaching materials, insurances, and living expenses. The granted amount should be determined by the degree levels and categories of the applicant.

I. Overseas Chinese descendants:

1. Doctoral degree students: 70,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 to 4 years.
2. Master's degree students: 60,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 2 to 3 years.
3. Bachelor's degree students: 50,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 4 to 5 years.
4. Advanced vocational school students: 50,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
5. Secondary vocational school students: 30,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
6. Senior high school students: 40,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
7. Non-degree trainees (including language students): 30,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 1 year.
8. Short-term program trainees: 3,000RMB/person/month, granted for the learning duration)

II. Students from Hong Kong, Macao, Taiwan and Overseas Chinese:

Each student will be granted 2000RMB as living allowance each month, ten months per year. Other expenses such as tuition, teaching materials, accommodation allowance and insurance will be transferred to the relevant schools and universities. The duration of the funds complies with the length of schooling.

04 Application Conditions

1. Descendants of the overseas Chinese and Chinese descendants from the countries of 'Maritime Silk Road' who are in favor of the 'in favour of the "One China" policy', friendly toward China and in good health. Students from Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan region should be the descendants of Jimei alumni, in favor of the 'One country, two systems' policy and in good health.
2. Abide by the laws and regulations of the Chinese government and meet the relevant admission requirements of the application school.

3. Applicants' qualifications and age limit:

- (1) Applicants for secondary vocational schools or senior high schools should obtain the junior high school diploma or higher level certificates and be under the age of 18.
 - (2) Applicants for bachelor's degree or advanced vocational schools should obtain the senior high school diploma or relevant certificates and be under the age of 30.
 - (3) Applicants for master's degree program should obtain bachelor's degree or higher level certificates and be under the age of 35.
 - (4) Applicants for the doctoral degree program should have master's degree or higher level certificates and be under the age of 40.
 - (5) Applicants for the non-degree training courses and short-term studies should be under the age of 40 and meet the qualification requirement of the relevant schools and universities.
4. Applicants for the degree education program should acquire the Chinese language proficiency required by relevant faculties.
5. Awardees of other scholarships should not be granted Tan Kah Kee scholarship.

06 Basic material

01 An application Form for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship.

02 The photocopy of the passport or other identification.

03 The authenticated degree certificate and the transcript.

04 HSK certificates, students (except those from Hong Kong, Macao, Taiwan and Overseas Chinese) applying for the English teaching courses should provide the Certificates of English language proficiency.

05 An Evaluation Form from the school of graduation or a Letter of Recommendation.

06 A letter of reference from overseas Chinese celebrity of the home country (for descendants of the Jimei schools alumni in Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan region, a letter of reference from Jimei Alumni Committee of the region or Jimei Alumni Association is required.)

07 A study plan.

08 Other materials required by the schools applied.

Assessment and Distribution

1.The assessment of the scholarship is carried out under the principle of 'openness, fairness, justness and selecting the best'. The Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation evaluates the candidates recommended by relevant schools and universities by the means of centralized review and submits the assessment materials to the leading group of the Scholarship. After further examination, the Group determines the final awardees and the funding limits and confirms the decision by publishing the notice on the websites of Jimei Schools Committee as well as those of the schools and colleges. The relevant schools and universities release the notice to the awardees.

2.An enrollment ceremony for the scholarship winners will be held and the award certificates be awarded.

3.After the tuition, accommodation and insurance fees are deducted, the rest of the scholarship for degree and non-degree education students will be paid by month as the living expenses.

4.An annual assessment for the awardees should be conducted to decide whether the scholarship can be extended according to their performance at school. In case of the student's violation of the laws of the Chinese government or the regulations of the school, their pursuit of activities that do not conform with their identity, the fact of providing false materials, taking an improper learning attitude or failing to meet the academic requirements of relevant schools, the scholarship can be suspended under the assessment and evaluation by leading group of the Educational Foundation for further examination.

Regulations for the implementation of Tan Kah Kee Scholarship were revised on January 2, 2019.

ABOUT XIAMEN UNIVERSITY

Xiamen University (XMU), founded in 1921 by renowned patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, was the first Chinese university established by an overseas Chinese person. XMU has long been listed among China's leading universities on the national 211 Project, 985 Project and Double First-Class Initiative, which was launched by the Chinese government to support selected universities in achieving world class status. Nestled snugly between green hills and the blue sea, XMU is renowned as one of the most beautiful universities around the world for its excellent education facilities and beautiful environment.

Motto: Pursue Excellence and Strive for Perfection

The phrase "Pursue Excellence" can be traced to the Book of Changes, a canonized Confucian classic containing the following sentence: "As the movement of the heavens is forever dynamic, so the superior man pursues excellence all his life." This phrase was hung over the podium at XMU's inauguration ceremony on April 6, 1921 and stressed by Mr. Tan Kah Kee as a commitment to excellence when the University was being founded. It reaffirmed China's determination to resume its rightful place in the world.

The phrase "Strive for Perfection" is taken from the chapter of Great Learning in the Classic of Rites, in which great learning is defined as the ability to explain and exemplify virtues, to show love and concern for people, and to strive for perfection. It was the motto of the University designated by President Lim Boon Keng when XMU was a private university.

The emblem of Xiamen University was designated by Mr. Tan Kah Kee upon the founding of the University. At the top of the circle are the four traditional Chinese characters for "Xiamen University", while at the bottom are the words of "Xiamen University" in Latin – UNIVERSITAS AMOIENSIS. The three stars on the shield represent spirit, universe and human beings, which are the three major elements in nature in the theory of traditional Chinese philosophy. The gate at the center of the shield represents the University's commitment to opening its doors to talent. The four Chinese characters on the ribbon mean "striving for perfection", which is part of XMU's motto.



2024 XIAMEN UNIVERSITY

I. XMU Today

Xiamen University currently comprises Siming Campus, Zhangzhou Campus, Xiang'an Campus and XMU Malaysia. XMU consists of a graduate school, six academic divisions, 34 schools and 17 research institutes. In 2022, six XMU disciplines – education, chemistry, marine science, biology, ecology and statistics – were included in the nation's list of disciplines for achieving world-class status. XMU ranks among ESI's global top 1% in 19 disciplines, with chemistry, materials science and engineering in ESI's global top 1%. XMU currently has a faculty of nearly 3,000, of whom 74% are full or associate professors. Among them, 35 are the members of the Chinese Academy of Sciences or of the Chinese Academy of Engineering. XMU currently has an enrollment of more than 45,000 students, including over 21,000 students in bachelor's degree programs, 19,000 in master's degree programs, and 5,000 in doctoral degree programs.

XMU implements a comprehensive global outreach strategy. The University has signed cooperation agreements with 265 overseas universities. Actively involved in international Chinese education, XMU has built 14 Confucius Institutes and 48 Confucius Classrooms in 12 countries on five continents, the highest numbers with the most extensive geographic coverage among Chinese universities on the List of "Double First-Class" Universities. In July 2014, XMU Malaysia broke ground, making XMU the first Chinese university to open an international campus, hailed as a jewel on the crown of the "Belt and Road Initiative".

II. Eligibility

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be ethnic Chinese from countries along the Maritime Silk Road, and hold a valid foreign regular passport.
2. Applicants shall adhere to the One China Principle, be friendly to China, abide by the laws and regulations of the Chinese Government, and be in good health.
3. Educational background and age limits (as of September 1, 2024):
 - (1) Bachelor's degree programs: holding a high school diploma or above and being under the age of 30;
 - (2) Master's degree programs: holding a bachelor's degree or above and being under the age of 35;
 - (3) Doctoral degree programs: holding a master's degree or above and being under the age of 40.

Notes:

- (1) Applicants who have been awarded any other scholarship are not eligible for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships.
- (2) Former Chinese citizens who have acquired foreign nationality and their children of foreign nationality as well as individuals of foreign nationality whose parents are Chinese citizens, need to pass both the preliminary review of citizenship status made by XMU before being admitted and the final judgement of citizenship made by the entry and exit administration department of China's public security authorities after the study in XMU begins. Applicants who fail to pass the preliminary review or verification of citizenship will be deemed to have voluntarily relinquished their eligibility for admission, as well as the subsequent academic registration that they may obtain. IV. Language Proficiency Requirements

Applicants should submit valid HSK certificate. For programs in Humanities, Economics, Management, Law, Arts and Traditional Chinese Medicine, HSK band 5 with a score of 210 or above is required. For programs in Sciences, Engineering and Medicine, HSK band 4 with a score of 210 or above is required. As for HSK requirements for Chinese language major of Overseas Education College, please refer to OEC website at <http://oec.xmu.edu.cn>. Applicants whose previous degree programs were taught in Chinese may provide the medium-of-instruction certificate issued by the previous institution as a substitution.

Note:

- (1) Doctoral students will have the tuition waiver during the 4th academic year.
- (2) Tuition fees are subject to change upon approval by price regulators.

2. Accommodations

Due to the limited availability of on-campus accommodations, priority will be given to students whose scholarship includes accommodation subsidies, and the remaining on-campus accommodations will be given to students whose scholarship does not include accommodation subsidies, as well as to self-financed students. The international student apartments on the Siming campus offer 2-person rooms, with accommodation fees per person ranging from RMB 35 to RMB 65 per day. Students on the Xiang'an campus will be accommodated in suites, each of which comprises 4 double-rooms. The accommodation fee is RMB 1,600-4,000 per academic year. Students who fail to secure on-campus accommodation are expected to make arrangements for off-campus accommodation on their own before arrival. The monthly rental of apartments near the Siming campus is around RMB 2,500 per room. For enquiries, call + 86 (0)592 2183606. 3. Cost of living: RMB 1,000-1,500 per month.
4. Cost of insurance: RMB 800 per year.

VI. Duration of Scholarships

1. Bachelor's degree programs: 4 or 5 years;
2. Master's degree programs: 2 or 3 years;
3. Doctoral degree programs: 4 years.

Note: Scholarship recipients will be subject to annual review in accordance with the relevant management regulations of the scholarships. Those who pass the review can continue to apply for or enjoy the scholarships in the next academic year. Those who fail the review will be suspended or disqualified from the scholarships. The specific regulations and methods of the annual review shall be subject to the latest notice issued in the current year.



VII. Scholarship Quota

20 students for bachelor's degree programs, 15 students for master's degree programs, and 3-5 for doctoral degree programs.

Note: Final quota will be determined by Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Committee.

VIII. Scholarships Coverage

1. Standard of scholarships: RMB 50,000 per year for bachelor's degree programs; RMB 60,000 per year for master's degree programs; RMB 70,000 per year for doctoral degree programs.

2. Distribution of scholarships: Scholarships will be first applied to the deduction of tuition and insurance fees, and the rest will be paid monthly.

Note: If living on campus, scholarship recipients need to pay on-campus accommodation fees and utility costs according to the University's regulations.



IX. Application Period: December 1, 2023 to April 10, 2024

X. Application Procedures

Application for the scholarships will be considered only after the applicant has been admitted to Xiamen University.

Applicants shall complete online application at <http://application.xmu.edu.cn> and upload the scanned copies of the Application Form for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships, Certification of Chinese Origin and related supporting documents (<https://admissions.xmu.edu.cn/cn/info/1136/1997.htm>). The Application Form for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships should be completed in Chinese or English with handwritten signature from the applicant. The Certification of Chinese Origin should bear the stamp of the recommending organization and handwritten signature from the person in charge. In general, mailing of paper-based application documents is not required.

XI. Selection and Notification

Applications for the scholarships will be evaluated on a competitive basis through an open, fair and impartial process. XMU will prepare a short-list of candidates for the scholarships and submit it to the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Education Foundation for evaluation and then to the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Committee for approval. Scholarship decisions will be made on the basis of the applicants' academic performance, language proficiency, research competence, letters of recommendation and overall merits.

HQU INTRODUCTION

Huaqiao University (HQU), founded in 1960, is a university directly under the United Front Work Department of CPC Central Committee (Overseas Chinese Affairs Office of the State Council). It has emerged as the pivotal national hub for promoting Chinese language and cultural education. Acknowledged as the National Cultural Caliber-focused Education Base for College Students, HQU has also been designated as the leading university in driving innovation and entrepreneurship education reform at a national level. Additionally, the university has garnered accolades as the distinguished national model institution for teacher assessment and evaluation reform, while serving as the base for preserving and inheriting the rich legacy of traditional Chinese culture. In 1983, HQU became one of the universities that received priority support from the CPC Central Committee. In 2018, HQU was listed under Fujian's Double First Class Initiative to be built into a world-class university with first-class disciplines.

HQU is the first institution of higher education named after Huaqiao (Overseas Chinese), and one of the first universities that enroll overseas students. HQU aims to serve the overseas Chinese and spread Chinese culture, committing itself to the school principle of Integration of Chinese Wisdom and Foreign Expertise, Unification of Moral Character and Professional Excellence. Educating students both morally and intellectually, HQU is dedicated to cultivating high-quality talent with innovative spirit, practical ability, global vision and social responsibility. By adhering to the educational policy of "facing overseas, facing Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan", HQU has been cultivating over 200,000 students of all levels since its establishment, among whom over 60,000 alumni are distributed in Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan and other countries or regions overseas, and are committed to promoting friendship, communication and cooperation between China and those countries or regions.

HQU International Exchanges and Cooperation

Engaging itself in international exchanges and cooperation, HQU has signed cooperation agreements with over 280 universities, research institutes and governments from 44 countries and regions. It now has 136 admissions offices across the globe. In order to better serve overseas Chinese and to promote Chinese culture, HQU has undertaken efforts in non-governmental Chinese language and cultural education, as well as public outreach and diplomacy. Scholarship Assessment and Management

1.Applications for the scholarships will be evaluated on a competitive basis through an open, fair and impartial process. HQU will evaluate applicants in terms of their academic performance, language proficiency, research competence, letters of recommendation and overall merits, and submit the short-list of candidates to the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Education Foundation for evaluation and approval.

2.Admission Letters and Visa Application Forms for Study (JW202) will be sent out afterwards, with which students apply for study visa at the local Chinese Embassy and register at HQU on time. Students who fail to register on time will be regarded as giving up the offer and will have to return JW202 to HQU. HQU will organize physical examination after registration. Only those who pass the physical examination will get admitted officially.

3.An annual assessment for the awardees will be conducted.Students who pass the annual assessment will continue to be granted the scholarship for the following year. Otherwise the qualifications will be canceled.

Generally speaking, the awardees cannot change their schools, majors, or extend study periods. In case the awardees have to change majors or schools, or extend the study periods, they should submit the application to Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation. Students who change their majors, schools, or extend study periods, drop out of the school, or suspend schooling without approval will be deprived of the scholarship.

1. Brief introduction to Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

Tan Kah Kee Scholarship was set up in 2017 to further implement the spirit of the letter from General Secretary Xi Jinping of the CPC Central Committee to Jimei Alumni Association, to better promote the monumental contributions of the famous patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tah Kah Kee, who is praised as “the flag of the oversea Chinese and the glory of the nation”, to inherit and to carry forward the Tah Kah Kee Spirit as well as to attract and encourage the outstanding overseas Chinese students and Chinese descendants to pursue their studies in Xiamen.

2. Scholarship funding quota

20 undergraduate students, 25 graduate students(together with Xiamen University,Huaqiao University,Xiamen University of Technology), 5 doctoral students(together with Xiamen University,Huaqiao University).The final funding quota will be adjusted by the Tan Kah Kee scholarship leading group according to the actual application.

3. Funding Criteria

The scholarship covers such expenses as tuition, accommodation allowance, teaching materials, insurances, and living expenses. The granted amount should be determined by the degree levels and categories of the applicant.

- 3.1. Doctoral degree students: 70,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 to 4 years.
- 3.2.Master's degree students: 60,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 2 or 3 years
- 3.3Bachelor's degree students:50,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 4 or 5 years

4. Entry Requirements

- 1. Descendants of the overseas Chinese and Chinese descendants from the countries of ‘Maritime Silk Road’ who are in favor of the ‘in favour of the “One China” policy’, friendly toward China and in good health. Students from Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan region should be the descendants of Jimei alumni, in favor of the ‘One country, two systems’ policy and in good health.
- 2. Abide by the laws and regulations of the Chinese government and meet the relevant admission requirements of the application school.
- 4.3. Educational background and age limits (as of September 1, 2024):
 - 4.3.1.Bachelor's programs: hold a high school diploma or above and be under the age of 30;
 - 4.3.2.Master's programs: hold a bachelor's degree or above and be under the age of 35;
 - 4.3.3.Doctoral programs: hold a master's degree or above and be under the age of 40.

4.4. language proficiency requirements for degree programs

Applicants for programs taught in Chinese should achieve International Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 4 or above, and within the validity period. Applicants who have finished their highest diploma completely in Chinese are exempted from proof of Chinese Language Proficiency Test, but they must present a medium-of-instruction certificate.

4.5 In accordance with Article 5 of the Nationality Law of the People's Republic of China, a person whose parents are both Chinese citizens and have both settled abroad, or one of whose parents is a Chinese citizen and has settled abroad, shall not have Chinese citizenship if he or she has acquired foreign citizenship at birth. If such a person applies to study in a bachelor's degree program at JMU as an international student, in addition to meeting the University's all other application requirements, he or she is required to have held a valid foreign passport for at least 4 years and have actually resided in a foreign country for at least 2 years in the past 4 years (as of April 30, 2024) (9 months of residence in a foreign country counts as a full year). The dates of the entry and exit stamps in the passport will be followed in the determination of the actual length of foreign residence. This requirement is also applicable to residents of the Chinese Mainland, Taiwan, Hong Kong or Macao who have emigrated to a foreign country and obtained foreign citizenship and are applying to study in a bachelor's degree program at JMU as international students.

4.6 Only after being officially recognized by the Division of Exit and Entry Administration of Public Security Bureau as foreign citizens, can foreign citizens of Chinese origin apply for Residence Permit in China and register their academic records as international students.

4.7 Awardees of other scholarships should not be granted Tan Kah Kee scholarship.

5. Application Period

Applicants should apply to the Admission office of Jimei university before May 10th, 2024.

II. Candidates and enrollment plan

1. Candidates include descendants of the overseas Chinese and Chinese descendants from the countries of 'Maritime Silk Road' who are in favor of the 'One China' policy, friendly to China and in good health.
2. 20 undergraduate students and several postgraduate students will be funded. The specific quota will be adjusted by the Tan Kah Kee Scholarship Leading Group based on the actual application situation.

III. Admission requirements

1. Students with foreign nationality. According to the Nationality Law of the People's Republic of China, both or one of the parents are Chinese citizens and have settled in a foreign country and students who have foreign nationality at birth and do not have Chinese nationality. Chinese citizens who apply to study at the university as foreign students after immigrating abroad must hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for more than 4 years (inclusive), and have a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate within the last 4 years (as of April 30 of the year of admission) with records of actual residence abroad for more than 2 years (actual residence abroad for 9 months in a year can be calculated as one year, subject to the entry and exit signatures).
2. The health status complies with the relevant provisions of the "Exit-Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China".
3. Applicants need to provide letters of recommendation from Chinese associations (including clan associations) or an influential Chinese in their country.
4. Educational background and age requirements:
 - (1) Students applying for undergraduate program must obtain a high school diploma or above (or equivalent academic qualifications), be over 18 years old and no more than 30 years old;
 - (2) must obtain a bachelor's degree or equivalent/above and be no more than 35 years old.
5. Chinese proficiency requirements
 The Chinese proficiency of students applying for undergraduate program must reach Level 4 of the International Chinese Proficiency Standards (hereinafter referred to as HSK). Those who use Chinese as the teaching language at the high school are exempted from submitting the HSK Level 4 certificate, but a proof that proving Chinese is the teaching language must be submitted.

IV. Application and admission process

1. Online application

- (1) Application is submitted online. Applicants shall log in to the Admissions System for International Student of Xiamen University of Technology (<https://admission.xmut.edu.cn>).
- (2) Applicants shall fill in true information accurately, completely and validly. If admission and enrollment are affected due to incorrect information, missing information, or false or invalid information, any adverse consequences and responsibilities shall be borne by the applicant.
- (3) Applicants should upload application materials as required (see the attached list, color scans are required), and keep the originals for future reference. If the application materials are not in Chinese or English, a notarized Chinese or English translation must be submitted. Forms, texts, certificates with more than one page should be stamped with a seam seal or an official seal on each page. For detailed application materials, please see the attachment "Application Materials List for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship Student of Xiamen University of Technology in 2024".
- (4) Application deadline: May 15, 2024.

2. Qualification review

The application materials will be reviewed by the school in 15 working days. During this period, applicants can log in to the Admissions System for International Student of Xiamen University of Technology for the application progress and related notifications.

3. Examination admission

- (1) The university will organize interview for students who passed the examination and select the best students based on the examination results in late May, 2024.
- (2) The university selects the best students according to their comprehensive scores.
- (3) The university will send the "Admission Notice" before August 15, 2024. Admitted new students should bring the "Admission Notice" and other relevant materials to the Chinese embassy or consulate abroad for visa application.

VII. Registration and admission review

1. Registration

All new students must bring their Admission Notice and relevant original documents to the school as scheduled for admission procedures. Students who are unable to arrive at the school on time for some reasons should apply for a leave to the school management department and a leave should generally not exceed two weeks. If no leave is acquired or the leave is overdue, the student will be deemed as giving up his/her qualifications for admission.

2. Admission review

After new students enter the school, their admission qualifications will be reexamined in accordance with relevant national and school regulations. Students who fail the reexamination will be dealt with in accordance with the relevant regulations on admissions.

VIII. Others

1. If the admissions procedures in the Brochure are inconsistent with the relevant regulations of the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Education Foundation, the latter shall prevail.

V. Admission selection

(II) Assessment

Xiamen Ocean Vocational College will assess the students who have passed the qualification examination in the middle and late May, focusing on their language communication ability and comprehensive quality.

(III) Xiamen Ocean Vocational College will select the best applicants according to their qualification examination and assessment results.

The admission letter and the visa application form for foreign students to study in China will be sent out successively in July.

VI. Scholarships and funding standards

International students admitted to Xiamen Ocean Vocational College can apply for scholarships, including Tan Kah Kee Scholarship and other Scholarship for International Students.

Funding standard for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship: 50,000 Yuan/Person/Academic year;

The foreign students admitted to Xiamen Ocean Vocational College need to be reviewed according to the procedure, and the scholarship will be granted on a monthly basis after passing the review.

Scholarships can be used to pay for tuition, accommodation, insurance, teaching materials, living expenses, etc.

Scholarships cannot be shared at the same time. Applicants can only get one of the scholarships at most.

Xiamen Ocean Vocational College will comprehensively review the academic performance and language ability of scholarship applicants. According to the scholarship selection method, we will adhere to the principle of standardization, objectivity and fairness, select the best scholarship candidates from the admitted students, and report to the school and the superior competent department for approval. SCHOOL PROFILE

Jimei Industrial Middle School was initially founded by Mr. Tan Kah Kee (Tan Kah Kee) in 1920 as Jimei School of Business, which has more than one-hundred-year history. The college is located beside the Jimei Lake, Xiamen. JMIC is also adjacent to the Xiamen Jimei 3.Jimei University & College Village. As a member of Jimei Schools, the Jimei Industrial Middle School strong cultural reflects the spirit and value set up by Mr. Tan Kah Kee. Its beautiful learning environment, advanced teaching equipment, comfortable living accommodation and qualified teaching faculty make it the most preferred vocational school in Xiamen.

Jimei Industrial Middle School covers an area of 236,000 square meters of school premises. The total school building covers the area of 235,100 square meters and teaching & assistant buildings covers the area of 91,695.85 square meters . The number of enrollment scale is up to 6,800. JMIC has a total fixed asset value of 670 million yuan and the total value of teaching and practice equipment is 122 million yuan, even JMIC has 300,000 collections of paper books. There are 6,670 students , 454 staff and teachers in JMIC. Among them,there are 337 professional teachers, 98.52% professional teachers own the bachelor degree or above. At the same time, the teacher student ratio in school is 19.79:1.

The college has cultivated, and focuses on "Modernization, Internationalization, Informationization, Optimization and Specialization academically". According to the regulation, the Jimei Industrial Middle School plans to enroll 10 Tan Kah Kee Scholarship students of Chinese descendant along the "Maritime Silk Road" in 2024. Qualified candidates of Chinese descendant can apply for attending Jimei Industrial College with scholarships.



II. Admissions Conditions

- 1.Applicants should be the descendants of overseas Chinese from the countries along the “Maritime Silk Road”, and should adhere to the “in favour of the “One China” policy”, friendly toward China, and be in good health.
- 2.Applicants must obtain a diploma of junior high school and have the basic ability to communicate in Chinese and Chinese characters. HSK Certificate of Level 3 or above are required.
- 3.Applicants should be between the age of 15 and 18.

III Admissions Category/Deadline/Major

- 1.Admissions Category: Secondary vocational school students
- 2.Admissions Deadline: May 15th, 2024
- 3.Admissions Majors: International Business (Duration: 3 years)

IV. Scholarships Funding Standards

- 1.Funding Standard of “Tan Kah Kee Scholarship”: 30,000 RMB/per-person/per-schoolyear (Duration: 3 years), 10,000 RMB for tuition, 20,000 RMB for accommodation, textbooks , living expenses and other expenses.
- 2.Overseas Chinese applicants are to be granted the scholarships only after assessment according to certain procedures.
- 3.Applicants who have received other scholarships granted by Chinese government or host schools are denied Tan Kah Kee Scholarships in principle.

V. Admission Materials

The applicants should provide the following materials:

- 1.Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Application Form
- 2.Copy of passport or other identification
- 3.Two-inch color bareheaded photos
- 4.The authenticated diploma and transcripts of junior high school or above are required. If you study in a country where 5-year compulsory education is required for junior and senior high schools, you should also provide a notarized certificate of student status which is certified by the graduated school. The length of being educated should be at least for 3 years.
- 5.HSK Certificate of Level 3 or above
- 6.An Evaluation Form from the school of graduation or a Letter of Recommendation
- 7.A letter of reference from overseas Chinese celebrity of the home country(for descendants of the Jimei Schools alumni in Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan region, a letter of reference from Jimei Alumni Committee of the region or Jimei Alumni Association is required).
- 8.Study Plan in China
- 9.Previous Medical History or A Guarantee of No Significant Disease
- 10.Applicants should have certain custodians who can be the parents or inhabitants entrusted by the parents authorization to the guardian (All foreign students who apply for admission to our school must have a designated guardian. The guardian may be a foreigner or Chinese who is entrusted by his parents to live permanently in China).

ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

2024 JIMEI MIDDLE SCHOOL

I. Admission Criteria

Applicants for the Tan Kah Kee Scholarship should meet the following criteria:

1. Being the descendants of overseas Chinese in countries along the “21st-Century Maritime Silk Road”, the ‘in favour of the “One China” policy’ and in good health. Those from Chinese Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan should be the descendants of Jimei High School’s alumni, upholding “one country, two systems”, and in good health.
2. Abiding by China’s laws and regulations and meeting the School’s admission criteria.
3. Age and education background:
Holding a diploma of junior high school or above, no less than 16 and no more than 18 years old in principle.
4. Chinese proficiency:
Holding a certificate of HSK Level 4 or above, or the equivalent. Able to understand high school courses taught in Chinese, including Chinese Language and Literature, Mathematics, English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Politics, History, Geography, Information Technology, General Technology, Music, Fine Arts and Physical Education.

II. Materials to be Submitted by Applicant

1. Application Form for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship.
2. Photocopy of passport or other identification certificate.
3. 2-inch color bareheaded photo.
4. Notarized latest diploma and transcripts in Chinese or English. A notarized certificate of student status certified by the graduated school. The length of being educated should be at least for 3 years.
5. Relevant Chinese proficiency certificate. HSK Certificate of Level 4 or above.
6. A testimonial or recommendation letter from the last school of graduation.
7. A reference letter from a local overseas Chinese association or a local overseas Chinese with influence; (or from a local Jimei Alumni Association branch or the Jimei Alumni Association, for the descendants of Jimei High School’s alumni in Chinese Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan).
8. A study plan in China written in Chinese.
9. Applicants under 18 must submit the Notary Certificate of Guardian in China.
10. Previous Medical History or A Guarantee of No Significant Disease

III. Evaluation and funding criteria

1. The Leading Group will specify the quota for the scholarship, and determine the winners based on the list of candidates recommended by the admissions department.
2. Applicants who have received other scholarships granted by Chinese government or host schools are denied Tan Kah Kee Scholarships in principle.
3. The Program offers each enrolled student a scholarship of RMB 40,000 per academic year for 3 years.
4. The scholarship shall be used for tuition (RMB 20,000 per academic year), accommodation, textbooks, notebooks, living expenses, etc.



IV. Education and Management

Jimei High School is responsible for the education and management of its students and sets much stricter standards for graduation than for admission, according to relevant Chinese regulations on the education of international students and students from Chinese Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan as well as the Program’s characteristics and requirements.

The performance of the winning students will be assessed every year, and the qualified students will continue to enjoy the scholarship for the next academic year. Violating Chinese government laws and school rules and regulation or engaging in activities that do not comply with my student status or providing false materials, after the foundation’s evaluation and report to the leading group for examination and approval, the scholarship qualification may be cancelled.

It formulated the Measures for Administration of International Students Status and the Measures for the Management of International Students. Also, it lists Spirit of Tan Kah Kee, Overview of Chinese Culture and History of Overseas Chinese as compulsory courses, and organizes 1 activity per semester to honor the Spirit of Tan Kah Kee.

The grant of the diploma is conditional on completing 3 years courses and passing the provincial general examinations of all the courses.

3. April to May: Review of applications.
